


# Redemption for OHS in '22

Redemption.

That is heavy on the minds of Tyler Ahring's Owensville Dutchmen baseball team after just missing out on a Four Rivers Conference (FRC) championship with losses to Pacific and St. Clair down the stretch.

They were also in prime position to end an over 40-year district title drought as the top seed before being upset by Salem in the first round of the Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) Class 4, District 9 Tournament at Sullivan High School.

Of the 20 players making up Ahring's varsity baseball roster, 12 of them are seniors.

Dutchmen that will be suiting up for the final time in orange and black this spring include Eoin Krupp, Landon Valley, Gavin Loague, Jon Saunsaucie, Connor Flynn, Dezmyn Moore, Logan Evans, Derek Brandt, Dominic Grigaitis, Michael Steinbeck, Eli Wilson and Hunter Engelbrecht.

Four juniors rounding out the list of upperclassmen on the varsity Dutchmen baseball roster include Bryce Payne, Austin Long, Will Lauth and Wyatt Kramme.

Rounding out the varsity roster will be the sophomore trio of Layne Evans, Jordan Rabbitt and Garrett Crosby along with freshman Landon Kramme.


Payne and Wilson will both be dualsport athletes also participating in track throughout the spring.

"I'm really excited to get this season going," Ahring said. "We've got a lot of experienced guys coming back that are hungry to claim conference and district

titles that were right there for the taking last year."

One big highlight of the upcoming season is a regular-season game on Saturday, April 16 against the Roxanna (III) Shells that will be played at Busch Stadium in downtown St. Louis.

"Our program has waited nearly three decades to get the opportunity to play on a Major League Baseball (MLB) field," Ahring said. "I'm happy for my guys that they will get this chance of a lifetime."

Additional highlight games in April will feature Military Appreciation Night on Friday, April 22 against Potosi along with Alumni Night on Friday, April 29 against Four Rivers Conference (FRC) foe New Haven.

Senior night is currently set for Monday, May 9 against Steelville's Cardinals with a backup date of May 12 against Waynesville in case of inclement weather.

Assigned to MSHSAA Class 4, District 4, Ahring's Dutchmen will look to end their over four-decade district title drought against Cuba, Salem, St. Clair, St. James and Sullivan.

They will face all five of those schools at least once during the regular season.






This is also in addition to their annual tournament that they will host during the final full week of April featuring Fatima, Sullivan, St. James, Wright City and the St. Louis Patriettes.





Gehlert also ran with Weirich in the 4x800m relay while Richardson was a part of the state-


qualifying 4x200m relay team.


