

Loaded district awaits OHS Dutchgirl softball

A tough schedule that just got tougher. That is what Hannah Koppelmann's Owensville Dutchgirl softball team found out Friday morning when district assignments and classifications were released by the Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA).

As if having Sullivan fresh off another run to state in the district was not hard enough, Blair Oaks' Lady Falcons were added to the MSHSAA Class 3, District 5 Tournament field.

Blair Oaks and Sullivan faced off in a MSHSAA Class 3 state softball semifinal and both teams have the bulk of their rosters back from last year.

Other teams joining the Dutchgirls, Lady Falcons and Lady Eagles in the MSHSAA Class 3, District 5 Tournament field include Cuba, St. Clair, St. Francis Borgia and St. James

Owensville on the other hand has a team primarily made up of underclassmen.

A familiar face will look to help the Dutchgirls improve throughout the season.

Replacing Shane Hunt, former Dutchgirl softball player Rhiannon (Edler) Schaefferkoetter will patrol the first-base coaches box opposite Koppelmann.

"I'm really happy to have Rhiannon as my assistant coach," Koppelmann said. "She brings a lot of passion to the game and being a former Dutchgirl also helps."

Leading the way as the lone senior on the 2022 Owensville Dutchgirl softball roster is infielder April Jahnsen.

Juniors rounding out the list of upperclassmen for OHS include Grace Abell, Jessalyn Farris, Emma Daniels, Isabella Pratt, Anya Binkhoelter and Kate Blankenship.

Daniels and Blankenship will lead the infield at shortstop and first base respectively providing the most varsity experience among returning players.

Sophomores comprising the majority of the team in 2022 include Katie Loyd, Alison Daniels, Caidence Goodman, Bailee Dare, Hannah Berkaw, Jenna Vandegriffe, Savannah Knight and Danika Hinson.

Freshmen rounding out the Dutchgirl softball roster include Clara Julius. Claire Oswalt, Lily Barker, Trinity Rossi and Cailin Floyd.

With more flexibility in game scheduling, Owensville was able to switch up their tournaments and add more regular-season

Instead of going to Rolla in early October, Koppelmann's Dutchgirls will compete in the AA Tournament at Russellville High School in late September.

"We wanted to find a different tournament that was not so close to districts," Koppelmann said. "We felt like the one in Russellville fit our team this year."

Dutchgirl volleyball sees district landscape return to normal

Inserted into a tough Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) Class 3, District 8 volleyball tournament field that included the likes of Fatima and Blair Oaks last fall, Jamie Ridenhour's Owensville Dutchgirls team saw themselves moved back into the MSHSAA Class 3. District 9 field and a more familiar group of teams for 2022.

Looking for their second district title in a three-year span, Ridenhour's Dutchgirls will compete against Cuba's Lady Wildcats, Salem's Lady Tigers, St. Clair's Lady Bulldogs, St. James' Lady Tigers and Sullivan's Lady Eagles.

Six seniors will look to make that dream a reality for the orange and black.

Returning for their final season in an Owensville Dutchgirl volleyball uniform are Kylie Kitchen, Josie Gerlemann, Molly Wnuk and Drew Copeland.

Areturning All-Four Rivers Conference (FRC) and All-District player, Gerlemann was second on the team with 157 kills as a junior. She also led the team with 88 blocks last fall.

Kitchen will look to improve on her team-leading 37 aces from a year ago. She also led OHS with 364 assists as a junior.

Playing volleyball during her younger days, Mallory Eberlin also made the team to make it a six-pack of seniors.

Juniors rounding out the list of upperclassmen along with making up the majority of the 2022 Owensville Dutchgirl volleyball roster include Ally Gooch, McKenna Edwards, McKenzy Echols, Makensy Pigg, Ayla Schmanke, Hannah Stoker and Elise

Madison Lewis rounds out the varsity Dutchgirl volleyball roster as the lone sophomore.

Stoker, Schmanke and McFalls will also suit up for Misti Rutledge's junior varsity Dutchgirl volleyball squad throughout

Spending her high school volleyball days at Cuba, Alexis Decker will begin her coaching career as the freshman coach for the Dutchgirls making the move north up Highway 19.

Making up the Dutchgirl freshmen roster are Rachel Koepke, Clara Julius, Alivia Riddle, Payton Myers, Brooke Jahnsen, Abby Morgan, Addison Scheer and Ella Adkison-Farmer.

Opening their season Monday night at home against Linn, the Dutchgirls will have two more home matches tonight (Wednesday) against Washington and next Tuesday against Belle's Lady Tigers.

After their Highway 28 showdown with Belle, Ridenhour's Dutchgirls will only have a home date with Hermann's Lady Bearcats on Tuesday, Sept. 20 with their remaining matches over the span of a month all on the road.

Those will feature tournaments at Fulton, Hermann and Rolla in addition to regularseason matches at Capital City (Jefferson City), Rolla, Fatima, Union and Steelville.

Gridiron Dutchmen set sights on conference, district titles

Plenty of motivation.

Nathan Cabot's Owensville Dutchmen football team certainly has enough of it entering the 2022 high school gridiron season.

Losing to Hermann and Union by a combined three points last fall, the orange and black came oh-so-close to adding another Four Rivers Conference (FRC) title to their district crown that they claimed on their home field.

Graduating a number of key players including two-time FRC Offensive Player of the Year Brendan Decker, Cabot's Dutchmen return five starters on offense in addition to seven starters on the defensive side of the ball

Among those starters are offensive lineman Chance Clevenger (senior), Trey Johnson (senior) and Hayden Shoemaker (iunior).

Clevenger is fresh off a junior season that landed him 3rd Team All-State, 1st Team All-FRC and 1st Team All-District honors for the orange and black.

"Having the bulk of our offensive line returning will allow us to be able to run our offense more effectively," Cabot said.

Another key returner on the offensive side of the ball is senior Charlie Whelan.

Coming out of the backfield at times as a wide receiver. Whelan's foot earned him a lot of accolades during his junior season.

Named an All-FRC and All-District 1st Team Kicker. Whelan was also selected to the Missouri Football Coaches Association (MFCA) All-State 3rd Team as a kicker.

"There are some teams out there that don't have the luxury that we do," Cabot said. "Having a kicker the caliber of Charlie (Whelan) can be valuable on special teams or in a tight game."

Fresh off a state championship last spring in the Class 3 Boys 110-meter hurdles at the Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) Track and Field Championships in Jefferson City, senior wide receiver Bryce Payne will look to make new starting quarterback Blake Elliott's life a little easier.

Finishing with 472 yards receiving and five touchdowns through the air, Payne will likely be Elliott's number-one target.

Joining the offensive returners will be a handful of newcomers.


At 6-1, senior Gabe Soest will be a tall target for Elliott out of the backfield.

Doubling as an offensive lineman and a tight end, junior Garrett Crosby will be a valuable weapon as either a blocker or a big tight end in the flat.

Cabot's Dutchmen will be looking to utilize their full compliment of offensive weapons throughout the fall.

"Our philosophy is to use our speed, spread the ball around to our athletes and to



put our athletes into a position to succeed," Cabot said. We plan to use our offense to control the tempo of the game and to be aggressive with our defense applying pressure to our opponents."

Along with Clevenger on the defensive line, senior Hunter Boyer will look to improve on his 55 tackles, six sacks and six tackles-for-loss from a year ago.

Seniors joining Whelan, Payne, Clevenger, Soest and Boyer in their final season as an Owensville Dutchmen football player include Austin Long, Derrick Marquez, Trey Johnson and JJ Brown.

Juniors rounding out the list of upperclassmen in addition to Elliott. Shoemaker and Crosby include Tanner Meyer, Braydan McDaniel, Tyler Scheer, Isaiah Gates, Ja-Coby Limberg, Kaden Loeb, AJ Silvers, Landon Brown and Austin Mades.

Replacing the Trojans on the schedule in 2022 will be Warrenton's Warriors.

OHS opened their season Friday night against Cuba's Wildcats and will face Warrenton on Friday, Sept. 9 when they would normally face their Highway 19 rivals to the south.

After hosting Eldon's Mustangs this Friday night at Dutchmen Field, Cabot's orange and black squad will hit the road into Warren County to face Warrenton for the first time since 2001 and the Kevin Baldwin era of Dutchmen football.

Following their showdown with the Warriors, Owensville will begin their quest for another FRC title with home games against St. James and Hermann before closing September on the road at Pacific.

October action will see OHS host Union before traveling to Sullivan and St. Clair to close out the regular season.






Ahring's OMS harriers will compete throughout September in Linn (Sept. 10), Belle (Sept. 22) and St. James (Sept. 28).


