


"I enjoy working with the girls and helping them improve their skills," Wehar said.

Tough district awaits Dutchgirl volleyball

Come late October, three streaks could come to an end in Four Rivers Conference (FRC) and area volleyball.

For second-year head coach Jamie Ridenhour and her Owensville Dutchgirl volleyball team, they will be looking to end a 40-year district title drought dating back to 1979 this October.

"Our district got a lot tougher with the addition of Borgia and Pacific," Ridenhour said. "I feel like with what I have seen out of the team, we should be contenders for that championship game in October, but only time will tell. There is a lot of play between now and then."

Competing this fall in Class 3, District 8 along with the Dutchgirls, Borgia and Pacific will be Salem, St. Clair, St. James and Sullivan.

Owensville and the rest of the district field will also look to put an end to Borgia's 21-year reign of terror in district volleyball tournaments.

If a Ridenhour prediction comes true,

it could be the first year since 1994 that a non-Highway 100 volleyball team (Hermann, New Haven or Washington) wins the conference title.

"In the (Four Rivers) conference, I really feel like we should be able to push for a top-three finish," Ridenhour said. "I feel that Sullivan and St. Clair should be the front runners and considering we played a two-point match with them both last year, these games should be fun to watch.

Also according to Ridenhour, "The Four Rivers (conference) is easily one of the most competitive conferences in the state and there should be a lot of good matches within it this year."

Leading the way looking for Owensville's second-ever district title are the senior quartet of Marissa West-Derby, Maddy Steever, Emma Jahnsen and Stephani Elliott.

Juniors rounding out the varsity squad include Emily McKinney, Haley Coello, Cadi Ruth, Grace McFalls and Taylor McClure.

Making up Misti Rutledge's junior varsity squad included sophomores Kyla Hendrix, Anna Heidbrink, Paige Deimeke, Keira Hendrix, Kayden Wood, Shelby Malone and Olivia Vandegriffe along with the freshmen duo of Josie Gerlemann and Kylie Kitchen


Coach Ridenhour also has a good problem to have before the start of the season.

"Right now, I can't really pick a standout player," Ridenhour said. "The younger players are really coming on strong and the older players are only getting better with that type of play and pressure."

Courtney Castor's freshmen Dutchgirl volleyball team will consist of Mallory Eberlin, Drew Copeland, Molly Wnuk, Maddy Crull, Payton Boyd, Avery Bastunas, Harley Pyrtle and Abby Terry.

"I am excited to get started with our season," Ridenhour said. "The girls have worked incredibly hard the last couple of weeks in practice and I truly hope that it is going to show up on the court."



Dutchmen football coaching staff has new and familiar faces for 2019

Of the six Owensville High School football coaches from last year, only two remain for the upcoming gridiron campaign.

One of those is new Dutchmen head football coach Nathan Cabot.

Cabot takes over the program from Dale Long who is now the Activities Director at Southern Boone High School in Ashland.

"I'm excited to see what our season has in store for us," Cabot said. "We've got a young team that is improving with each practice and that will compete each and every night."

Along with being head coach, Cabot will oversee with the offensive and defensive lines. He will also have help in the form of assistant coaches Dean Pohlmann (defensive line) and Shane Hunt (offensive line).


"We have a lot of new players out there on the field and they'll only get better with time throughout the season," Cabot said.







Johnson and Hunter Gibson.

Opening their 51st season of Owensville Dutchmen football this Friday night, OHS will host Potosi's Trojans at Dutchmen Field beginning at 7 p.m.

"We're still working out the kinks but we'll be ready for Potosi come Friday night," Cabot said.

After the season opener at home, Cabot's young Dutchmen will spend the month of September on the road with games against Eldon, Cuba, St. James and Hermann.

Opening the October portion of the 2019 season, Owensville will host Pacific's Indians for homecoming on Friday, Oct. 4.

Following a road showdown with Union the next Friday, OHS will close the regular season with home games against Sullivan and St. Clair.

First-round district action could be a rematch with St. Clair or Sullivan depending upon how the first nine weeks of the season turn out.

Other possible first-round district foes in the MSHSAA Class 3, District 2 Tournament include Bayless, Confluence Prep Academy, Roosevelt and St. Francis Borgia.

Sullivan, St. Francis Borgia and Roosevelt were all Class 4 football teams last year before making the drop to Class 3 for the upcoming 2019 season.

"I'm really excited about our district and think we can compete with anyone in there," Cabot said.
