

Throughout any scheduled varsity and JV doubleheader, a game of name that Kramme could easily be played with four of them between the two rosters.





As a returning All-State athletes in three events, senior Emma Daniels will be looked upon to lead the Dutchgirls in defense of their conference and district Returning seniors joining the elder Daniels will include McKenzy Echols and Ashlynn Weigel.





Ely will also be patrolling the outfield as a member of Steven Kemp's Dutchmen baseball team.


