### **2022 Parade Grand Marshals**

Deer season was a favorite time of year, not only for the Woolley Family, but the entire community. From opening until close, a large crowd always gathered to visit and see the big bucks that were harvested.

When Wimp wasn't working at his grocery store, you could find him officiating baseball, softball or basketball games or attending auctions. He was a member of the Belle Lions Club, Masonic Lodge and Faith Baptist Church.

After retiring, Wimp purchased a couple of lots on the Gasconade River, built a clubhouse, bought a boat, and soaked up countless hours on the beautiful river. He enjoyed having his family and friends visit "Woolleyville" (aka

Wimp had to undergo heart bypass surgery in September of 2017. He now resides at Gasconade Manor in Owensville. He tries to remain active, despite his health issues. He enjoys the special musical guests, playing Bingo, taste testing at the Cooking Corner and, of course, attending church services.

For many years, Virginia was an active member of the Belle VFW Ladies Auxiliary. She was one of the key team members in getting the Veterans Memorial placed at the four-way stop in Belle. She was also an avid bowler and golfer, taking home many tournament trophies. Virginia still enjoys her hobby of crocheting. She also loves watching the next generation of grandchildren play sports. She very rarely misses a ballgame. If she's not outside tending to her beautiful yard, you can find her inside watching the St. Louis Cardinals, old western shows, or RFD TV. She loves music and is a huge fan of Gene Watson. She is also an active member of Faith Baptist Church.

Wimp and Virginia are parents to six daughters: Debra Rhea Wright of Belle, Terra Sue Wright (passed away October 30, 2002), Vicki Stallman of Moberly, Sherri Lea Crider (passed away October 10, 2021), Christi Ann Lurk of Branson and Kerri Jo Jones of Belle. They also raised four grandchildren: Nichoel Snodgrass of Belle, Christopher Wright (passed away January 17, 2021), Jonathan Woolley of Belle and Crystal Wright of Joplin. They are the proud grandparents of 11 grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren.



Wimp and Virginia say they are excited and humbled to serve as Grand Marshals of this year's Belle Fair. They have fond memories of past fairs and have had the opportunity to witness many great performers on stage. Wimp has had to miss the past several years due to health reasons, but when he was able to attend, he enjoyed the musical guests as well as the truck and tractor pulls, where he often served as an announcer

Virginia has attended the Belle Fair every year since it began. Her favorite headliners were Sonny James and Roy Acuff. She said she was looking forward to seeing Loretta Lynn on stage, but her performance was canceled after she was put on bed rest while pregnant with twins. She's looking forward to many more years of all that the fair has to offer to the Belle community.
