Seven starters return for Dutchgirl nine

Losing just two starters from last fall's 14-13 season, Owensville Dutchgirl head softball coach Hannah (Wehar) Koppelmann has plenty of reasons to be excited for the upcoming season.

Fall Sports Preview

"I'm really excited for this season and I think we have another winning season like last year," Koppelmann said.

Showing the way for the diamond Dutchgirls will be six seniors in Halie Boyer, Kaitlyn Nelson, Alyssa Belloir, Katelyn Landolt, Paige Bossaller and Gabby Bunners.

Landolt is getting closer to returning to action after tearing her anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) during basketball season last winter.

"We're anxiously awaiting Katelyn being cleared to play," Koppelmann said.

Boyer will make the move from the hot corner (third base) to behind the plate in the catcher position.

"She's (Halie) quick and that will help us our back there behind the plate," Koppelmann said. "She does a good job blocking and she's got a good arm."

Boyer will be opposite junior starting pitcher Addison Wright who had a solid sophomore season as a left-handed pitcher.

"We're going to have an solid battery between (Halie) Boyer and (Addison) Wright," Koppelmann said.

Belloir will see time in the outfield in addition to Bossaller at second base.

Bunners will occupy first base unless in relief of Wright and Nelson will be in outfield in addition to making the occasional relief or starting pitching appearance.

Juniors joining Wright on the roster include outfielder Paige Loyd, shortstop Anna Finley, utility player Leah Reed and outfielder Shelby Malone. As the lone sophomore on the squad, April Jahnsen will spend most of her time on the diamond in the infield.

Freshmen rounding out the Dutchgirl softball roster include Grace Abell, Emma Daniels, Layni Heidbreder, Sophia Steinbeck, Hannah Nelson and Kate Blankenship.

"We've got a couple of girls new to us that are really going to help us out," Koppelmann said. "We have more speed and athleticism this year which will help us on the base paths."

After opening their season in the Peoples Bank Back to School Softball Classic in Sullivan, Koppelmann's Dutchgirls will make their home debut in 2020 on Monday, Aug. 31 against the Capital City Lady Cavaliers out of Jefferson City at OHS Field with a 4:30 p.m., first pitch for varsity action.



Dutchgirls eye first district title since '79

In spite of not knowing their district opponents until mid-September, Jamie Ridenhour's Owensville Dutchgirl volleyball team still has a goal of ending their district-title drought that dates back to 1979.

"One of our team goals this year is to win a district title and get that 41-year monkey off our back," Ridenhour said. "Regardless of who is in our district, we'll be ready to play them when the time comes."

Leading the way towards ending the 41-year long drought will be Dutchgirl senior volleyball players Emily McKinney, Haley Coello, Cadi Ruth, Grace McFalls and Taylor McClure.

"These five seniors have worked hard for me over the last four years and I would love nothing more than for them to end their high school volleyball careers with a district and (Four Rivers) conference title," Ridenhour said.

McKinney enters her senior season as a returning All-FRC and All-District player.

Juniors also making Ridenhour's varsity squad include Olivia Vandegriffe, Anna Heidbrink, Keira Hendrix and Kyla Hendrix.

"Our juniors have also worked their tails off in the summer and during practice making themselves better," Ridenhour said. "We'll be looking to the Hendrix twins to help on the outside and at setter."

A trio of sophomores will also join their upperclassmen teammates on the varsity roster in Josie Gerlemann, Kylie Kitchen and Molly Wnuk.

Misti Rutledge's junior varsity squad will have a mixture of freshmen, sophomores and a junior.

Allyssa Taylor will be the lone junior on the JV squad along with sophomores Payton Boyd, Avery Bastunas, Harley Pyrtle, Drew Copeland, Kitchen and Wnuk.

New to the Dutchgirl volleyball coaching staff this fall is former player Taylor Payne.

Coaching the freshmen squad, Payne's roster will consist of Hannah Stoker, Payton Harness, McKenna Edwards, Anya Binkhoelter, Ayla Schmanke, Elise McFalls, Emily Krause and McKenzy Echols.

Following their jamboree scrimmage with Sullivan last night (Tuesday), Owensville will start their 2020 season on Monday, Aug. 31 at home against Linn's Lady Wildcats with matches starting at 5 p.m., at Owensville High School.

COVID-19 has already reared its ugly head canceling a varsity tournament at Fulton and a freshman/junior varsity tournament in Pacific during the month of September.

Owensville's quest for their first-ever FRC title in volleyball will begin on Tuesday, Sept. 22 when they will hit the road to face Union's Lady Wildcats starting at 5 p.m., at Union High School.

"As strong as the (Four Rivers) conference has been over the years, there is not one match that you can chalk up as an automatic win," Ridenhour said. "We've got to be ready to play no matter which conference opponent we face."

In an effort to recognize the five seniors in this time of uncertainty, OHS will have volleyball senior night on Tuesday, Sept. 8 as part of a Highway 28 showdown against Belle's Lady Tigers with matches also starting at 5 p.m.

OHS' first road contest will be Thursday, Sept. 3 in Jefferson City against the Capital City Lady Cavaliers in their newly constructed gym.



Seeing the largest number of attendance for summer runs in program history, Owensville High School head cross country coach Matt Candrl has plenty of reasons to be excited about the upcoming fall season.

"I'm really excited about our teams this year,"Candrl said. "This has been the largest number of boys and girls in attendance for summer runs in the history of the program."

Finishing sixth in Missouri Class 3 Cross Country last fall and capturing their fourth straight Four Rivers Conference (FRC) team title, Candrl's Dutchgirls have three returning harries from that squad.

Led by defending district champion Mekayla Gibson, Owensville will also be led by returners Katie Candrl and Kyah Weirich.

"Mekayla finished 31st at last year's state meet just missing the top 25 and all

state honors," Candrl said.

"Kate Angell is in her first year running cross country and has moved herself into the number three spot for the Dutchgirls," Coach Candrl said.

With Saylor Richardson as the lone sophomore, Candrl's Dutchgirl squad is rounded out by the freshmen foursome of Jasmine Duncan, Cassidy Gooch, Katelyn Holtzer and Peyton Weiland.

"Currently rounding out the top seven

for the Dutchgirls will be sophomore Saylor Richardson, freshman Jasmine Duncan and seniors Isabelle Bruckerhoff and Julianna Watkins," Coach Candrl said.




