

"Brynn has touch luck with injuries the past two seasons," VanLeer said. "We hope that she'll get healthy and be able to have a great senior year."


Rounding out the Dutchgirl basketball roster are the freshmen duo of Lainey Moss and Cameron Ryerson.



"Landon (Kramme) has battled a shoulder injury the past year and I look for him to do great things now that he's healthy," Howard said.



"It's awesome that we have 13 freshmen out for wrestling this season," Howard said. "I'm looking forward to seeing these guys learn and grow on the mats."



With the continued success for the Falcon football program, the Dutchmen will face a short-handed Blair Oaks basketball team in Wardsville.

December basketball will see the Dutchmen enjoy some home cooking by playing five of their six games at Owensville High School.

It will begin on Friday, Dec. 1 with a tripleheader against Salem's Tigers beginning with C-Team action at 4:30 p.m.

After a Monday, Dec. 4 road game at Washington, the orange and black will cap the 2023 portion of their schedule with a four-game home stand.

That will begin on Wednesday, Dec. 6 when Andy Jahnsen's Southern Boone Eagles pay a visit to Gasconade County for a tripleheader with C-Team action tipping off at 4:30 p.m.

They will then cap that week on Friday, Dec. 8 with another boys tripleheader against Linn's Wildcats.

Owensville will then close the pre-Christmas portion of their schedule hosting St. Francis Borgia's Knights on Monday, Dec. 11 and St. Clair's Bulldogs on Friday, Dec 15

Five teams along with the host Dutchmen

will open the 2024 portion of the season at the annual Owensville Varsity Boys Basketball Tournament.

In the tournament field along with the host Dutchmen will be Cuba, Newburg, Pacific, Steelville and Southern Boone.

After a road trip to Steelville following the Owensville Tournament, VanLeer's Dutchmen will head west to Frontenac, Kan., for tournament action during the third week of January.




